PINK EYE IN ROOM 5

Dear Room 5 Families,

There has been an extraordinary amount of pink eye cases in our classroom lately. Despite our daily efforts in sanitizing the classroom and hand-washing reminders, it seems to continue to spread quickly in our class. Some children have even had it reoccur after receiving treatment. If your child has a confirmed case of pink eye, please consider the following:

- O The incubation period is from 24 to 72 hours.
- O It is still considered contagious from the onset of the signs and symptoms, and while the eye is still red and draining.
- O Children are advised to stay home until signs and symptoms are gone or until 24-hours **after** starting treatment and signs/symptoms have **greatly reduced**.
- O If the eye discharge is thick and white or yellow, the child should stay home until the discharge has stopped completely.

My team and I have also noticed that children who are on treatment but are still feeling itchiness in their eyes are touching their eyes frequently thus spreading it. If this is the case, please consider keeping your child home to help us minimize the spread.

With the end of the school year approaching, we have many fun activities planned and would be sad if your child or one of our team members missed these events. We will continue to do our best to continue daily sanitizing and thorough handwashing. We appreciate your never-ending support!
