Hello everyone!

I am pleased to announce that our first "Child-As-A-Teacher" event of the year will be taking place on November 3rd! You will be visiting the class for 45 minutes. A certain number of slots per time are given in order to accommodate the number of bodies in our small classroom, so please try not to change your time slot unless absolutely necessary. Your child will guide you through the classroom and give you a little snapshot of their day. They will show you some of the materials that they are learning and working on in class. A set of guidelines regarding your role as the "student" will also be provided a week before the event.

We will keep the morning as "normal" as possible. Please wait outside the entrance for your child to greet you and take you inside. The children will be aware that, although this is a very special day, the classroom ground rules remain the same. They will be using their quiet voices and walking feet, being gentle to the works, choosing materials they have had lessons on, putting works back where they found them, and being kind to their friends. They expect their guests to follow the same rules! Although I will be in the classroom, I will MAINLY be observing - the kiddos are running the show! The children will work with you for 40 minutes, the last 5 minutes will be for clean up and goodbyes.

If your child is on a half-day schedule, you may take them home after your time slot to avoid the extra trip back and forth. If your child is not a half-day student, but you would like to take them home early, that is okay too. Please let us know if you do so that we can sign them out on our roster.

Please note that this is a **PARENTS ONLY** event. Please plan childcare for any younger siblings. If both parents are unable to attend, you may ask another family member to take your place. If only one parent can attend, please note that a second C.A.T day will take place in the spring. PLEASE let me know ASAP if no one at all will be coming as it may be best for your child to stay home so that they do not feel left out.
