- -April 8 Solar Eclipse Reminder

For the safety of our students, we have made the following plans for April 8, the day of the eclipse.

### Infant, Toddler, and Primary

ECC students will remain indoors with the curtains closed during the eclipse hours. Prior to the eclipse, they will have an extended morning outside recess. Primary students may watch a portion of the NASA livestream of the event.

### **Elementary**

Students will be indoors with their curtains closed between 10:00 a.m. and 1:15 p.m. while the eclipse is taking place. Tammy, Leticia, and Kayla have the AASA writing test that day. Once they are finished with their test, students can participate in activities. All other classes will have the total eclipse livestream in progress. Classes are planning a variety of fun eclipse activities while they are indoors.

We sent out a form last week for parents to give permission to allow their child to view the eclipse under the supervision of an adult if they send in a pair of viewing glasses for their child and sign the form. We had over 200 students sign up! Emily, our science teacher, and some other adults will come around to each class during the eclipse and invite students who have permission and glasses to view the eclipse. Given the many fake glasses on the market, we cannot be responsible for providing them, and children will not be allowed to share them.

### Middle School
