- Half-Day- Due to conferences, September 22 & 29 will be half days for students with an extended day and half-day contract. I do like to point out that the children do notice that some of their peers leave while they stay and can get upset about this. If your child is staying, it would help to explain at home. There is no instruction time as I will be in and out of conferences. This means that ALL kindergarteners that stay will be sent to the nap area at 12:30. They will need a nap bag sent with: a fitted sheet, small blanket, and travel-size pillow.
