Hello Room 5,

Every year our school is required to undergo an inspection by the Department of Health Services (DHS). Although we are not aware of the exact date of their visit, we are expecting them any time now. We would appreciate your help in making sure we are meeting all the requirements set by DHS. You can help us by doing the following:

- Packing your child's lunch in an INSULATED lunch box/bag and include an ICEPACK
 - This includes ALL FOOD and PM Snack
- Making sure not to pack foods, such as popcorn, that could pose as a choking hazard.
- Making sure to send an extra set of clothes if they don't have any already.
 (Ms. Maria will be sending emails out to those who do not).
- Call/email attendance anytime your child will be absent/tardy/picked up early.
- If your child has a food allergy and uses any meds/epi-pen:
 - o Be sure the proper forms have been filled out
 - Replace any expired meds/epi-pen when needed.
