- **ALL-DAY CONTRACTS Pickup-** It appears that there has been some confusion regarding the 2:30-2:45 carline. Children who have an EXTENDED DAY contract will be sent to carline, not ALL-DAY contract students. This is because we need to use the carline lane for the extended day contract students since their days end at 2:30. If you have a student with an ALL-DAY contract, please park and walk to the gate to ask for your child. This way the afternoon care staff will know that your child is leaving and can mark that on their roster. We apologize for the confusion and for your patience as we iron out this beginning-of-the-year details. Thank you!!!
- **Pizza Friday-** We will be continuing to have Pizza Friday this year. The fee will be \$110 this year to cover the price increase in pizza. This is a one-time fee and will cover the whole school year. Please be sure to let me know if your child prefers cheese or pepperoni as this helps me to figure out how much of each to order. 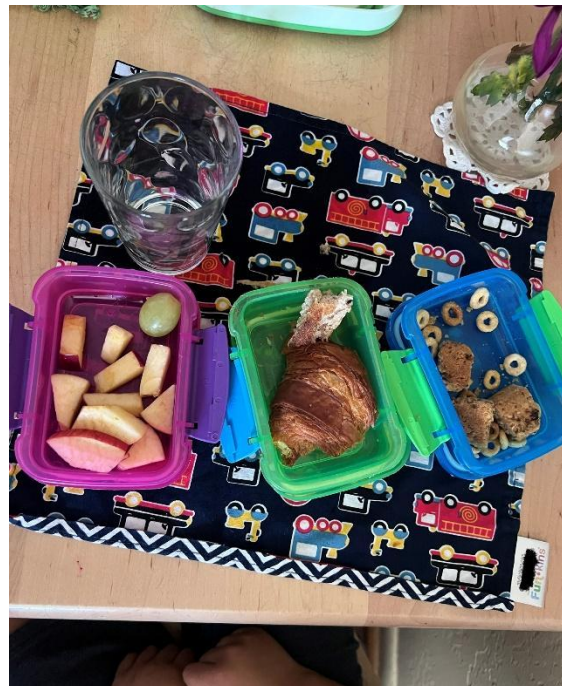
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For those that may have missed our Parent Orientation, we shared that one of the problems we noticed last year is that lunch boxes with attached lids tend to take up a lot of space on our small tables. We observed that this caused a lot of frustration for the children and caused some of our glassware to fall. If you already have a lunch box such as a BENTGO box, it would help if you teach your child how to take out the insert so that they can put the lid back in their bag and be able to eat their lunch from the insert. Containers with a removable lid are best, because the children can just put the lid under their container while they eat.
